

Willebroek Solo Contest.

General Provisions

Registration & Contest Proceedings

- 1** The contest is meant for all brass players (including trumpet and horn). Both Belgian and foreign participants are allowed to participate. In the highest category "From 19 years old", the instruments are limited to the brass band family:

Soprano Cornet Eb, Cornet, Flugelhorn, Tenor Horn Eb, Baritone, Tenor Trombone, Bass Trombone, Euphonium, Eb / Bb Bass
- 2** The call for participation in the contest will be announced by Brass Band Willebroek on its website www.brassbandwillebroek.be and social media.
- 3** The basic registration fee is 15 euros per participant and is paid online via our website.
- 4** Participants are not obliged to be a member of a brass band, association or other organization.
- 5** All participants perform one solo piece or part of a work with piano accompaniment, written specifically for the chosen instrument. The participant may request an exception by email, brassbandwillebroek@gmail.com. The organization recommends choosing a work that includes all musical aspects.
- 6** The participant who wishes to participate, completes the registration form on our website. Participation is only final upon payment of the registration fee and the submission of the piano score (with solo voice).
- 7** The winners of the category "From 19 years old" cannot participate in future editions of the Willebroek Solo Contest.

The closing date for registration is **Friday 1 September 2023**.

The contest is divided into 4 age categories. The participants will be limited to the following maximum duration:

Category	Duration
Up to and including 12 years old	Max. 6 minutes
13 to 15 years old	3 to 8 minutes
16 to 18 years old	4 to 9 minutes
From 19 years old	5 to 10 minutes

Each category has a limit of 25 participants, with the exception of the lowest category (up to and including 12 years old). 35 participants will be allowed in this category.

Works that are shorter or longer than the prescribed time will not be allowed to the contest. If the maximum duration is exceeded on the competition day, the jury will add a points deduction to the final result.

Participants who use the provided piano accompanists of the contest must - after contact with the pianist about date and location - arrange their own transport.

12

Brass Band Willebroek will provide two piano accompanists for the contest and also ensure that the participants can practice with this accompanist during the

preparation period for the contest. The participants are offered a rehearsal time of:

- Up to and including 12 years old: 10 minutes
- 13 to 15 years old: 15 minutes
- 16 to 18 years old: 20 minutes
- From 19 years old: 30 minutes

The participants are free to provide their own piano accompanist. The associated costs are paid by the participant.

Other live accompaniments are not allowed. Digital accompaniment is only allowed if stated in the score.

On arrival, the participants register at the reception with an identity card or passport.

15

Participants must register at the reception at least 1 hour in advance. If he or she is late due to his / her own fault, this candidate may be disqualified from the contest.

Transport and accommodation costs are the responsibility of the participant. Details of accommodation can be found on our web page: www.brassbandwillebroek.be/willebroeksolocontest

The participants must act completely independently. The teacher of the participant may sit next to the piano accompanist to give him / her instructions regarding tempo and interpretation.

18

The contest starts in 2 different halls: Voordrachtzaal and Schouwburg. In both halls, the lowest categories will start the contest.

19

The draw will be communicated by e-mail no later than 2 weeks before the event.

20

Cancellation of participation is only possible with proof of illness (doctor's certificate). The registration fee is hereby refunded.

21

The organizer of the contest is authorized to record all performances within the contest period acoustically and visually and to use these recordings to promote the contest. Furthermore, the organizer reserves the right to authorize radio and TV stations to record and broadcast all events of the contest and to produce and sell CDs, DVDs and other sound carriers of performances of the contest.

22

When registering, each participant agrees to the rules & regulations of the contest.

Adjudication & Proclamation

1

Brass Band Willebroek will appoint the jury members. 2 adjudicators per category will judge. All categories will be judged from inside a box, according to the system of "closed" adjudication.

2

Each jury member makes his own score on a maximum of 100 points, after deliberation a final result will be made. In addition, each jury member draws up a personalized feedback for each performance.

The results will be announced at the earliest 45 minutes after the category has been closed, the proclamation will take place in the hall where the contest took place.

4

At the proclamation, each participant will receive his or her points. The top 3 will be announced in a separate ranking. When the results are announced, participants receive:

- A personalized feedback by the jury team.
- A diploma indicating category, date / location, number of points received. The diploma is signed by the chairman of Brass Band Willebroek and the jury members.

The full results are published online on the website and social media.

The winner within each category will receive the following prizes:
